## Georgian winners keep up grand tradition

The 2013 Georgian Group Architectural Awards were announced at a ceremony held at Christie's auction house in London this week.

Craig Hamilton Architects won two categories, including New Building in the Classical Tradition for Onslow Park, near Shrewsbury (pictured).

Brewster Bye Architects,

Thomas Ford & Partners, RHWL and Brownhill Hayward Brown also won awards.

In all, 75 schemes were entered of which seven were winners and a further 10 commended, including Brock Carmichael, Elevation Design, JWA and Adam Architecture.

Now in its 11th year, the awards recognise projects

involving the restoration of Georgian buildings and landscapes across Britain.

Crispin Holborow, head of Savills country house department and a member of the judging panel, said: "Whether it be the restoration of a grand country house, the recreation of a Georgian landscape or a new building

in the classical tradition, it is clear that the Georgian principles of design are more popular than ever.

"Some of the entries are particularly heroic because they have been carried out with little hope of a commercial return."
